## Treasurer's Report (Jim Szwast)

The revised 2002 proposed budget with actual 2001 number was reviewed. The projected 2002 shortfall is \$13,000. (2001 shortfall \$7000, this includes the expenses for the veterans' Walk and sponsoring the new club). Some of the areas that have caused an increase from 2001 are: food costs, international contributions and dues (\$1700 less than 2001).

## Comments:

Suggested cutting the expense to the District convention from \$1800 to \$1200. Jerry Money will write a check directly from the Veterans Walk fund to RI - Polio Partners (\$1000) and will reimburse the "seed" (\$715) money and also see if the breakfast club could pay us back the "seed" money we advanced to them (\$500). This will help offset the deficit. However, even with these modifications we still will need to raise the dues.

According to the bylaws of the club we have to present a dues increase to the membership at large for ratification and also publish the increase in the Spray two times.

Suggested that we raise the dues enough so that we don't have to address this problem again any time soon. It also needs to be pointed out that Rotary International and district dues have also increased. We were also left with less in the budget (\$1987 instead of \$5000).
