**Last Week's Program Club Assembly**

President Clyde Taylor began the program by distributing to each member a three-point plan for accomplishing key issues. He then emphasized that we need quality weekly programs and urged all members to assist Programs & Fellowship Chairman, Kevin Lokey, with ideas and support. Clyde then discussed membership – recruitment and retention. This year Clyde would like to see us have a total of 127 active, dues-paying members; further, he encouraged every St. Simons Rotary Club member to begin that day recruiting active prospects. He noted that president-elect Leslie Mattingly is preparing a brochure on the club in an effort to assist in the prospecting process.

The third point of the president's message was how to identify and implement significant fund-raising activity to increase the club's ability to support local, community projects. He asked for volunteers for his "thinking committee" – one that would submit ideas for any fund-raising activity enabling the club to fund more projects on St. Simons Island. To that end, he introduced Tom Parker, community service director, who asked support from each club member.

Dick Wicker, International Service Director, talked about Paul Harris Fellows and the importance of all members participating in this program at some level. James Bruce, Club Service & Membership Director, reported on committee assignments for the coming year. He was followed by Rem Sims, who reported for Pat Storino, Club Relations & Public Relations Director, on committee assignments and the liaison of the committee to the local newspapers and radio stations.

Ted Wright, Vocational Service Director, introduced his committee members and announced that he wanted to resume "Classification Talks" during the third week of the even months ahead. Wrapping up the St. Simons Rotary Club's key issues for 2003-2204 was Kevin Lokey, Programs and Fellowship Director. While he admitted to being a one-man committee, he asked for the support of every club member to assist him in presenting important programs every week of the club year.

Clyde concluded the program by reinforcing the need for every member to serve the club this year – "get involved; offer assistance; serve when asked."
