Last Week's Program Classification Talks

Kevin Lokey, Stan Kyker, Reid Trawick



Ted Wright, Vocational Service Director, introduced Kevin Lokey, the first of three St. Simons Rotary Club members presenting classification talks. Kevin discussed his background and early days in Griffin, Ga. He attended the University of Georgia and graduated from Georgia State University. He spent time in New England before settling down in Griffin, where he opened the branch for A. G. Edwards Securities & Investment Firm. He left A. G. Edwards to enter the restaurant business; but was lured back to A. G. Edwards, this time in Brunswick, in 1999. He is active in community affairs when he is not working on estate planning for his customers. He enjoys hunting, fishing, tennis, golf and cooking. He and his wife, Linda, and their two children recently built a new home in Vassar Point on St. Simons Island.

Stan Kyker is a native of Porterfield, CA. California was home until he and his wife moved to St. Simons Island in March, 2002, "from one coast to the other." After graduating from UCLA, he stayed in Southern California planning to be a teacher. He tried endeavors for six years, accepting in 1968 the position of manager of the Southern California Restaurant Association, a job he held for 30 years.
