Last Week's Program**UBS Cup Joel Willis**

Kevin Lokey introduced Joel Willis who presented the program on the UBS CUP 2003 which will be held at the Seaside Course, Sea Island Golf Club, St. Simons Island.

Willis has been manager at Epworth By The Sea, United Methodist Conference Center, on St. Simons since 1979. He is also treasurer of the South Georgia Annual Conference, United Methodist Church Board of Trustees and is a past chairman of the Brunswick-Golden Isles Chamber of Commerce.

A native of Atlanta, Willis graduated from the Georgia Institute of Technology with a degree in industrial management. He is married to the former Ann Bell, who also has been employed by Epworth for the past 24 years. They have two adult children, Ashley LeZotte and Joel Willis Jr.

As chairman of the United Bank of Switzerland Cup Committee, Willis discussed all facets of the upcoming event – United States vs. The Rest of the World. Arnold Palmer is USA Captain; with Tony Jacklin, ROW Captain. Twelve members comprise each team. Each team has six players 40-49 years of age; six players 50 & older. Team play will be Friday and Saturday, November 21 & 22; with individual play on Sunday. There will be a three million dollar purse for this event.

Willis explained the reasons for the return of the UBS Cup to Seaside Course – success of the Walker Cup; professional way UBS was staged last year; hospitality of the Sea Island Company and the people throughout the Golden Isles.

UBS Cup will be televised on the golf channel where 50 million people will be watching. Willis stressed how this event showcases Brunswick & the Golden Isles. "You need to buy tickets, come to the event, bring your friends and talk to everyone about it," he urged. Four day season pass and individual tickets are on sale now. The prices increase after October 15. Ticket order forms were distributed.

Prior to showing the video of last year's UBS Cup, Willis concluded by asking everyone to get involved. He noted that this event could become a PGA-sanctioned event.
