

Program, November 30, 2004 Elizabeth Hines Georgia Sea Turtle Foundation



Elizabeth Hines, the Executive Director of the Jekyll Island Foundation, spoke to us about the activities of the Foundation and particularly its efforts to provide rehabilitation for ill and injured sea turtles. The Foundation is a non-profit organization which was founded in 2000.

The Foundation has partnered with Dr. Terry Norton and the Georgia DNR to form the Georgia Sea Turtle Center which will be housed on Jekyll Island in a renovated power plant. Plans for the building include educational exhibits, surgical and rehabilitation areas, an information center and gift shop. The Center will be open all year and will be free of charge to visitors. There is currently a \$2 million campaign under way to raise the funds for the Center. The Woodruff Foundation has issued a \$750 thousand challenge grant for the campaign.

Elizabeth pointed out some interesting facts about sea turtles. They have existed unchanged for more than 200 million years. There are five species of sea turtles that live in waters off the Georgia coast. It takes some 35 years for a sea turtle to be able to reproduce. Only one in five thousand eggs survives.

Elizabeth invited our Rotary Club members to become involved in the sea turtle movement by volunteering time or money to the Foundation.
