Last Week's Program (June 14, 2005) Classification Talks Sal Cenicola, Everett Millican & Frank Sidella



Leon Jorgensen presented today's program and the three speakers.

Sal Cenicola was raised in New Jersey where boxing is a big sport. He told of putting on the gloves when 7 years old, starting as an amateur fighter at age 15, and going on to win the Golden Glove Championship and several gold medals in Europe. Sal recalled disappointment when Carter boycotted the Olympics. He turned pro and experienced disappointment again—he was denied a shot at the championship because of politics. Sal went into the hair styling business with ventures such as "The Upper Cut." He is now working with Northwestern Mutual and lives on the island with his family.

Everett Millican was born in Atlanta and has resided on the Island since Sept. 2000. Following graduation from college, Everett's occupation dealt with property-casualty insurance— which he found dull. Much of Everett's talk was about his career organizing and directing golf tournaments. Everett recounted his group bringing tournament golf to Atlanta, creating the Atlanta Classic which today is the Bell-South Classic, associated pro-am activities (celebrities such as Bob Hope, Dean Martin et al), and all the associated highs and lows. Everett has directed a number of other major golfing events.

Frank Sidella has lived here 26 years. He spoke of his 3 careers: Military, Federal Government and Private Sector. Frank relayed experiences with the press and media, advising to always, "tell the media to put questions in writing and expect a response in writing." Frank entertained us with statements such as, "If you make the cover of Time, you'll wind up serving time." He recalled his career in Washington, seeing first-hand the Viet Nam protests, Watergate matters, and the Nixon investigations. Frank also recalled details of the Kennedy assassination proceedings. Frank, as a member of the Board for the Consolidated Federal Law Enforcement Center, was asked for an appropriate name for the Center. He suggested dropping the word "Consolidated," arriving at the group's current name. Frank was involved in FLETC being in Brunswick at its current location.
