### Author of Holy Land, Whose Land?

Wank Davis introduced Dorothy Drummond. Dorothy's travels have taken her to seventy countries. She brings a geographer's viewpoint and a love for history. She has spent most of her life as a freelance writer for geographical publications. She has been awarded Fulbright scholarships and is listed in *Who's Who in America*.

Dorothy's presentation centered around Middle East history and issues; e.g., Why Israelis and Palestinians claim the same bit of Middle East real estate?
