S. Gordon Rogers IV Executive Director Satilla RIVERKEEPER

Gordon Rogers talked about the Satilla and other Georgia rivers, emphasizing the necessity for everyone to work together to make sure the rivers continue to function as an important part of our environment.

He was raised in South Georgia, the son of the Rev. Sam and Helen Rogers of the South Georgia United Methodist Conference.

After living in several towns and cities in the region, he graduated from Glynn Academy and attended Oxford College of Emory University, the University of Georgia, and Skidaway Institute of Oceanography in Savannah.

He then joined the Georgia Department of Natural Resources at its Coastal Resources Division office in Brunswick, first as a fisheries statistician and later as a marine fisheries biologist and analyst. He later worked in the waste and recycling industry for nine years, based in Brunswick. He has also fished professionally and taught about fishing.

He became the Satilla RIVERKEEPER and executive director of the organization on Sept. 1, 2004.

He lives with his wife and two children in Waynesville.
