Dr. Charles Adams Epworth by the Sea

Dr. Adams has been superintendent of Epworth by the Sea since 2005, and has served on the Epworth board of directors since 1984.

He holds a bachelor of science degree from Valdosta State College, a master of divinity degree from Candler School of Theology at Emory University, and a doctor of ministry degree from San Francisco Theological Seminary. He has served many churches throughout Georgia.

He is a member of the Marshes of Glynn Rotary Club on St. Simons Island.

He gave a brief history of Epworth, which is a hospitality ministry of the South Georgia Conference of the United Methodist Church. Named for the English boyhood home of John and Charles Wesley, who lived and worked on St. Simons Island in 1737, Epworth was established in 1949 under the leadership of Bishop Arthur J. Moore.

Dr. Adams said Epworth primarily serves religious and non-profit groups.

He called Epworth a "safe, serene, secure place."
