Cassina Garden Club

Sharon Flores, chairperson of the Tabby & Tillandsia Garden Walk, was introduced by Marie Dodd. The garden walk, held by the Cassina Garden Club of St. Simons, is the first of any kind of garden tour to be held on Saint Simons Island.

The garden club dates to the 1930s and has been responsible for many community projects, including the restoration of the former slave cabins on Gascoigne Bluff that now house the Cassina Garden Club itself. All proceeds from the tour will go into a special fund to help renovate the cabins further.

The tour will include events May 4-6. A special lecture the night of May 4 by Ryan Gainey, a world-renowned garden designer, will kick off the weekend and will be followed by a special patrons' party.

The tour itself, including seven of the island's most beautiful gardens, will be from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on May 5 and 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. on May 6.
