John Hofmann

Born in Germany and educated in England, John spent his long business career with Bunge, a global food, commodities and agribusiness company. He retired as senior vice president.

He was responsible for originating, transporting and exporting basic farm commodities such as wheat, corn and soybeans from producing areas to consumers. He traveled extensively in Europe, Russia, Mexico and South America, as well as the Orient.

He has lived in the U.S. since 1956. He and his wife, Lisa, have three grown sons.

They bought a home in Sea Palms 17 years ago, visiting often before moving here seven months ago. They also have a home in Maine.

James (Wank) Davis

Born in Savannah, GA, and raised near there, Wank attended Armstrong College before obtaining a degree in marketing from the University of Georgia.

He has had a long career in banking and the financial industry in Georgia, working in such places as Savannah, Atlanta, Statesboro and Jesup before joining United Community Bank here.

He drew some chuckles from the audience when he talked about his athletic career (baseball) at Armstrong College in Savannah, where he improved his batting average from 0 to 0.063 from one year to the next. He attributed this athletic ability to being “small, but also slow.”
