Jim Bruner Glynn County Chief Engineer

The county's chief engineer gave a report on the progress of two important St. Simons Island traffic control projects: The proposed roundabout at the intersection of Demere and Frederica roads, and the SSI Gateway Project, which proposes a new traffic loop just off the causeway involving Demere, Kings Way and Sea Island Road.

The Demere/Frederica project will be a two-lane roundabout. He explained that a roundabout requires traffic entering the circle to yield to traffic already in the circle, as in the Frederica Road/Lawrence Road roundabout. That's different from a "traffic circle" in which traffic in the circle has to yield to traffic entering the circle, he said.

He said the Frederica/Lawrence Road roundabout is working well and he has not received "a single complaint."

The Gateway Project is a "loop" that would have traffic entering the island from the causeway proceed on Kings Way toward the Village, with the option of then turning left onto Sea Island Road (and then the option to turn right onto Demere). The goal is to reduce waiting time at traffic signals.

Neither project has a firm timetable. The design for the roundabout is not yet final. The design for the Gateway Project is done, but environmental issues are slowing the process.

Jim is a native Georgian, growing up in Glenville. He spent four years in the Navy Seabees and holds a degree in civil engineering from Auburn University. He has worked for Glynn County for more than 10 years. He is married with two grown sons and three grandchildren.

The chief engineer was introduced by Jim Bruce.
