Capt. Mike McKinnon Commanding Officer Naval Submarine Base, Kings Bay

Captain McKinnon gave a status report on his base, which recently was recognized with the military's 2007 Installation Excellence Award.

The submarine base has 8100 employees, including 5,000 military personnel. It operates on 25 square miles in Kings Bay, currently supporting six submarines, which will soon grow to eight. It has a \$500 million payroll, contributing significantly to the area's economy.

The base complement includes not only humans, but also dolphins and sea lions that patrol area waters for intruders.

He said each submarine has two crews, which rotate between sea and shore duty. On shore, they train in what Captain McKinnon described as "a submarine in a building" that can replicate what a submarine can do at sea.

A native of Tennessee, Captain McKinnon received his commission in May 1981, graduating from the United States Naval Academy with a Bachelor of Science degree in mechanical engineering.

Several sea assignments led to his command of the USS KENTUCKY.

His shore assignments included staff positions in Charleston, S.C., Norfolk, VA, and Kings Bay.

On Aug. 10, 2004, Captain McKinnon became the 16th commanding officer of Naval Submarine Base Kings Bay.

Captain McKinnon was introduced by Gary Schwartz.
