Ed Bruce SSI Rotary Scholarship Program & Student Presentations

Rebecca Farrow, chairman of the SSI Rotary Scholarship Committee, presented winners of the club's annual scholarships.

Winning two-year scholarships, worth \$1,000 per year, were Casey Pickler, Brunswick High School, who will study nursing at Coastal Georgia Community College, and Taylor Forst, Brunswick High School, who will study teacher education at Coastal Georgia Community College.

Winning four-year scholarships, worth \$2,000 per year, were Christine Amuzie, Glynn Academy, who will study bio-medical engineering at Georgia Tech; Andrea Nenzo, Glynn Academy, who will study teacher education at Berry College; Duane Carver, Brunswick High School, who will study pre-law at Georgia Tech, aiming to be a patent attorney in computer technology; and Teddy Michels, Brunswick High School, who will study music at the Savannah College of Art and Design.

Thirty-four applications were received this year with 12 finalists being selected for an interview. Six students were then selected from the interview process to receive our scholarships. Evaluation criteria included the student's academic background, community involvement, high school and community honors, high school activities, financial need and an autobiography.

Students must maintain a 2.5 grade point average each semester to continue to receive scholarship funds.
