Steve Brian

Steve Brian gave a status report on the Brunswick Golden Isles Airport and McKinnon St. Simons Island Airport.

He noted that Delta Air Lines committed in late February to making fares more competitive with Jacksonville, and urged Golden Isles residents to “take a look” at those fares before they book at other airports. And he said the Glynn County Airport commission is aggressively looking for additional carriers.

He said the new hotel at McKinnon Airport is on track and “general aviation will continue to grow.” McKinnon, he said, has twice as many takeoffs and landings as Brunswick, but is not considered a candidate for commercial travel, because it was not designed for that purpose.

Steve is a graduate of Auburn University in aviation management. He has 26 years experience in airport management, ranging from small to medium airports in the Southeast.

He is past president of the Georgia Airports Association.

He and his wife Vickie have two daughters.

Steve Brian was introduced by Past President (and past Assistant District Governor) Marie Dodd, who is chairman of the Glynn County Airport Commission.
