John Mathews introduced today's three speakers who shared in making the presentation. No incident of the Guinea Worm was reported last year; one more year of zero incidents and the condition will be classified as eradicated. The Guinea Worm Rotary Project is actually a clean water project. The speakers described the present Rotary project and how the SSI Rotary Club could participate in the new (second) project.

The presentation focused on Abidjan and neighboring villages. Abidjan is the largest city and de facto capital of Côte d'Ivoire (the Ivory Coast). Life in the villages was explained with the help of interesting visuals. Typical slides were Greeting at a Village; Carrying the Heavy Weight of Water; Drinking Water in Use Now; Clean Drinking Water Well and Pump; Visiting with Various Leaders; and Gifts: Yams and "Meredith the Goat." The comments about each subject were entertaining as well as informative. The group closed by talking about the local Rotary Club in Abidjan, referred to as the "Golf Club of Abidjan." A Q&A session followed the presentation.
