Joel Meyer General Manager Little St. Simons Island



Don Fielder introduced Joel Meyer, the General Manager of Little St. Simons Island. After presenting highlights of Joel's bio, Don announced a special discount being made available to our club members. Don also mentioned that Joel is newly engaged to be married.

Joel opened with a discussion of some humorous family matters, his six years at the King & Prince, and related a story about Cal Paynter. A show of hands revealed many present had been to Little St. Simons Island and would like to return. Joel's talk included an audio-video presentation about the Island.
