**GRSP Student** Sebastian Lindqvist, this year's GRSP student from Sweden, stopped by to say hello. He had positive things to say about the program and his expectations. Thanks, Sebastian. And thanks to host Sandy Sanders.

Don Fielder introduced Richard Wood who was accompanied by three members of the Authority: Bill Donohue, Executive Director; Eric Garvey, Sr. Director of Marketing; and Jim Broadwell, Project Manager. Richard and Eric shared in making the presentation.

The State purchased Jekyll Island from the Jekyll Island Club in 1947 for \$675,000. The Jekyll Island Authority was created and is now made up of eight members. Richard noted the Governor has appointed three Glynn County residents as members — a first. Jekyll somehow has been made a part of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act, passed in 1982 to prevent development on barrier islands. One implication is no flood insurance—resulting in difficulties in getting mortgages. The Authority is lobbying to have Jekyll removed from the Act. Richard and Eric discussed facilities, leases, and attractions such as the Georgia Sea Turtle Center. Encouraging news included the new 200-room facility replacing the old Holiday Inn. RFI 233 was explained, an information request to assist the Authority in plans for the Island. The four distinct courses of action discussed were: (1) status quo; (2) 2020 vision plan; (3) private sector master developer; and (4) conversion to a fee simple arrangement. A Q&A session followed.
