## Julie Hunter Signature Squares of Brunswick



Assistant Governor Clyde Taylor introduced Julie Harris and shared some facts about her background. Julie explained that today's presentation should define the Signature Squares organization and its objectives. She discussed all 12 historic squares, starting with Hanover and Wright. She hopes that Signature Squares is "the right thing at the right time." Its vision is to allow Brunswick to secure its town squares as places of significant historic importance, to foster community pride and to build upon the benefits of heritage tourism.
