Dr. Michael Bull Superintendent, Glynn County School System



Don Fielder introduced Dr. Michael Bull. Dr. Bull was formerly the Assistant Superintendent with the Gainesville School System. He has been a Principal of two schools, a Director of Mathematics, and Director of a South Carolina Regional Math and Science Center. His formal education includes a Bachelor of Science from Clemson, two master's degrees and a PH.D. from the University of South Carolina. He has also held positions at the College of Charleston, the Citadel, the University of South Carolina, Montana State and Cambridge College in Boston. He is married to Nancy Bull, who has been an educator for over twenty years.

Dr. Bull began his talk by restating his intentions to remain in his position for the remaining years of the term. He gave a comprehensive report on the school system's progress, issues and objectives. He described projects such a the 8th Grade Summer School and the 8.5 Grade. The objectives are grouped in four sets of goals: I. Educate all students; II. Develop the proper climate/culture (success, credibility, et al); III. Provide clean, safe and orderly educational facilities; and IV. Provide fiscal accountability to Glynn County citizens. Dr Bull concluded his talk with a Q&A session.
