Alan Garrett
US Army Corps of Engineers
Harbor & Channel Dredging



Don Fielder introduced Alan Garrett, Civil Engineer and Project Manager for the Savannah District US Army Corps of Engineers. Alan holds a BSCE, N.C. State, 1982 and MBA, Ga. Southern, 1991. Alan has 27 years with the Corps and is currently the Project Manager for the Brunswick Harbor Deepening and the Savannah Harbor Expansion Projects. Alan resides in Richmond Hill with his wife and two sons.

Alan did a great job explaining the history of the Corps, its mission statement and vision, makeup, chain of command, military and civil works, etc. He spoke of Savannah Harbor and Brunswick Harbor activities. Alan described dredging equipment and techniques such as using disposal areas and the protection of sea turtles. Alan talked in detail about the Brunswick Harbor Deepening Project and identified the key issue: funding. He closed the interesting presentation with a Q&A session.
