October 3, 2006 Mike Wiggins Former US Deputy Associate Attorney General



Don Fielder introduced Mike Wiggins. Mike served in the Bush Administration from 2001-2006, holding several positions in the Justice Department. Most recently he served as Deputy Associate Attorney General. His appointments prior to that included, among others, Acting Assistant Attorney General. Mike graduated *first in his class* from the University of Georgia School of Law.

Mike's presentation centered around homeland security, the fight against terror and the role of law enforcement. He started by talking of the horrors of 9/11 and the professionalism and dedication of law enforcement members since that day. He specifically praised the armed services, police and fire fighters. Mike discussed the activities of Homeland Security and his service in the Bush Administration. He closed the stirring presentation by discussing the theme of advancing human freedom against terror, followed by a Q&A session.
