

October 17, 2006 Classification Talks Wally Forsythe and Jack McDonald



Wall Forsythe, born in Louisville, Kentucky, and wife Lynn reside on St. Simons Island. Wally mentioned the recent, terrible automobile accident and thanked all for the great support he and Lynn received. Wally next spoke of his dad and the L&N Railroad. He recalled, among other things, seeing the Kentucky Derby thanks to his dad. Wally gave his talk in terms of timelines; e.g. 1949-1998. He included his schooling, military service and business activities. His career included sales, marketing, at least one significant innovation, and plant management. He spoke of Lynn's career and accomplishments. The talk was informative and filled with humor.

Jack McDonald and wife Mary Alice have three children. Jack is a retired US Army Colonel. He talked of his college experiences at Purdue and Texas A&M and his Army career of 22 years, serving in Korea, Japan, Ecuador, and Germany, with several stateside assignments. One military adventure in which he was involved was the *Berlin Tunnel*. This was a top secret, cold war project carried out in 1954-1955. The US had few spies in East Berlin and intelligence was scarce, thus the Tunnel—complete with communications cable. Jack described the project with clarity and an amazing amount of detail given the time allotted him on the program.

Both speakers offered to stay after the meeting for questions and answers. President Pat congratulated the two of them for being "true Rotarians."
