Brunswick Mayor Bryan Thompson**State of the City**

Bryan Thompson is Mayor of Brunswick and President/CEO of Blueprint Brunswick. He is a member of and serves on the boards of six additional organizations. His wife, Heather Heath, is Executive Director of Golden Isles Arts and Humanities Association.

The Mayor gave a lively talk on Brunswick: its past, the current state of the city, and action in progress. Among the issues and projects discussed were economic recovery from a 30-year decline; Blueprint Brunswick; growth; attracting investments; development and redevelopment; distressed properties and the \$100 program; crime, crime stats and what is being done; abandoned vehicles and "shade-tree mechanics"; the US 17 Highway Corridor status; the old paint plant site; Liberty Harbor; and more! The presentation was followed by a very comprehensive Q&A session. The Mayor dodged no issues.
