Lisa East
Executive Director
CASA Glynn



Stan Kyker introduced Lisa East, currently the Executive Director for CASA Glynn. Lisa has worked with abused children for the last 18 years and knows CASA makes a difference. Lisa and her family moved here from Texas 18 months ago. She resides on the Island with her husband and two children.

Lisa defined CASA as *Court Appointed Special Advocates for Children*. CASA works independently for the appropriate judge. She quoted numbers to describe the extent of child abuse, including nationally 1 million cases per year plus many unreported/unknown cases. 14,000 abused and neglected children in Georgia are in foster care, including the 150-200 in Glynn County. Lisa defined some percentages making up child abuse; e.g., 19% physical, 10% sexual abuse, and 8% emotional and neglect. She defined warning signs of abuse and talked at length about reporting cases and how to volunteer. The CASA web site is <http://www.casaglynn.org>. Following her presentation, President Pat presented to LISA a check for \$1,000 for CASA. Lisa expressed surprise and sincere thanks for the donation.
