Painting with Ken Wallin

The artist demonstrated his painting techniques and explained his philosophy for club members.

He has been painting nature, villages and the landscape for more than 25 years. His passion for the arts began in the fourth grade when he finished his work on time and his teacher gave him a paintbrush to work on a mural in the class to give him something to do.

Since that time he has trained in many workshops in France, the Southwest and with regional artists. He said these experiences helped him create his own unique style with paintbrush and palette knife.

His inspiration comes from his travels with his photographer wife Judy. These creative art adventures have taken them around the world. His favorite locations are France, Italy, Costa Rica and the coastal areas of the United States.

Art patrons often describe his work as powerful and magnetic, with a profound use of color to convey his passion for a particular region of the world. His work has been part of solo and group exhibitions with numerous awards for his use of color and the electricity in his oils.

Ken has combined his training in the arts with a Ph.D. degree in psychology. He has self-published works on anger control, positive thinking and how to use the arts and creativity as tools for health and healing.

He has recently published a book of his art and painting journeys around the world called "The Creative Art Adventures of Ken Wallin." The book contains more than 80 images of his work and is available at his gallery and regional bookstores.

Ken shows his work exclusively at his gallery and working studio in Redfern Village. In his studio, Ken paints daily. Painting workshops and individual lessons are available throughout the year.

His work also is represented at the J.J. Gillespie Gallery in McMurray, Pennsylvania, the Globe Gallery in North Georgia, and the Redbird Gallery in Seaside, Florida.
