Hamsa Thota

A 30-year member of our club and a past president, Hamsa gave an overview of those three decades of service.

He recalled the controversy over admission of women members, saying he was on the "right side" of that issue.

He also talked about neighboring clubs that he and other SSI members helped get started, and about the exchange with clubs in India.

Eric Andreae

Eric recalled growing up in a small village in Switzerland and becoming a physician like his father.

He moved to the United States to find work in his field and landed a job in Chattanooga, TN, although he spoke little English.

He spent 42 years in private practice in New York City. Among his New York patients were some artists, one of whom gave Eric a painting that started the art collection he has today.

Eric also talked about his service as volunteer medical director of the Coastal Medical Access Project, which provides free medical care to coastal Georgians in need.

Fred Collins

Fred, a banker, is a new member of our club who skipped the Red Badge and went straight to the Blue Badge.

The reason – he explained – is that he has been a Rotarian for many years before coming here.

And he proved the point by recounting some of his more humorous experiences with club fund-raising over the years.
