Hedge Funds Gary Link

CEO & Managing Partner Stoneworks Asset Management

As manager of a hedge fund headquartered in London, Link gave club members a primer on this form of investment strategy.

He said the size of the hedge fund market exceeds 10,000 funds containing \$1.5 trillion.

But these funds, he added, are typically available only to sophisticated investors.

One of the major differences in a hedge fund and a more traditional investment, such as a mutual fund, is that hedge funds strive to generate good returns even when the market goes down by using such strategies as selling stocks "short," he said.

He added that if a person doesn't believe a fund manager can outperform the market, he should stick with index funds that simply track the overall market's performance.

Link, who has owned a condominium on St. Simons Island for years, is responsible for all non-portfolio activities for a \$200 million hedge fund.

He holds degrees from Cornell University and the London School of Economics.
