Richard Yarbrough Syndicated Columnist

The columnist showed off his well-honed sense of humor in a talk that – like his columns – pointed out the funny and not-sofunny aspects of state politics.

"You can't make this stuff up," he said after describing how a legislator sought to have clay made the state dirt of Georgia.

Yarbrough is into his third career as a syndicated newspaper columnist whose strong opinions are seen in more than 30 newspapers throughout the state, including the Brunswick News, reaching almost one million households per week.

He retired as vice president of BellSouth Corporation in 1993. He was responsible for the company's public relations and advertising. He then joined the Atlanta Committee for the Olympic Games as managing director of communications and government relations.

Yarbrough has published a compilation of his popular and opinionated columns entitled, "Squirrels at the Feeder: Taking Aim at Politicians, CEO's and Other Pests." He also authored the only book written on the 1996 Centennial Olympic Games in Atlanta, "And They Call Them Games."

He is a graduate of the University of Georgia, past president of the national alumni association, has been named the university's Outstanding Alumnus and has a room named in his honor at the Grady College of Journalism there.

Yarbrough and his wife, Jane, have two children and four grandsons. They live in Vinings.
