Community Image Awards

Vocational Service Director Robert Cable presented awards to the following:

The institutional award went to **Coastal Georgia Community College** for “dedication and commitment to the education of all citizens of Coastal Georgia.”

The award was accepted by CGCC President **Dr. Dorothy Lord**, who has led the institution for 17 years. She called her experience “a great ride.” She also talked about CGCC’s upcoming transition to four-year status, and the recent expansion to a Camden County campus.

Dr. Lord (who is a member of the Brunswick Rotary Club) was introduced by club member **Marie Dodd**, who provided a history of CGCC, which began in 1961 as Brunswick College – the first two-year Georgia college in the state’s university system. The name was changed to Coastal Georgia Community College in 1996 to better reflect the service the college offers in our five coastal counties: Glynn, McIntosh, Camden, Brantley and Wayne.

Marie called the award to Dr. Lord “a very modest recognition of your great value to higher education in our state and your commitment to our community.”

The individual award went to **Julie Hunter, co-founder and director of Signature Squares of Brunswick**, which was incorporated in December 2004 as a nonprofit organization with the sole purpose of restoring and preserving the parks and squares within the Historic District of the City of Brunswick.

She was cited for her “dedication and commitment to preserving the historical character and unique lifestyle of our community.”

The recipient said her work gives the area a “sense of place,” and ripple effects increase property values, leading to more preservation and restoration.

There are fourteen squares interspersed along Newcastle and Norwich Streets, stretching south of H Street to 1st Avenue. Signature squares works with the city on each project, with the amount budgeted through the city becoming a match to funds raised by Signature Squares.
