Glynn County Police Canine Unit Program and Demonstration

Officer Brian Faulk gave a brief talk about the Glynn County Police Department's Canine Unit before he and two colleagues gave a police dog demonstration at Epworth By the Sea.

Glynn County has had police dogs for 30 years, he said, and currently has two German Shepherds and two Belgian Malinois. Each team of officer and dog gets more than 400 hours of initial training, and the training continues throughout the partnership.

In addition to regular police duties, such as tracking suspects and lost children, and sniffing for illegal drugs, the canine teams also assist other agencies (i.e. Coast Guard, Customs).

The department keeps the dogs for six to eight years before retiring them. Most of the dogs come from Europe at 12 to 15 months old at a cost of \$5,000 to \$6,000 each.

The demonstration (outside the Epworth registration building) was done with a German Shepherd named Samo (Faulk's Police Service Dog) and a Belgian Malinois named Gator. They demonstrated subduing a suspect and finding illegal drugs.

Officer Faulk is a 13-year veteran with the Glynn County Police Department, where he was formerly a detective. He has nine years of experience with the canine unit.

A native of Brunswick, Officer Faulk is married with five children.

(Gary Schwartz introduced the program.)
