Shepherd Center

Shepherd Center is a private, not-for-profit hospital in Atlanta devoted for more than three decades to the medical care and rehabilitation of people with spinal cord injury and disease, acquired brain injury, multiple sclerosis and other neuromuscular problems.

James Shepherd (a member of the Atlanta Rotary Club) told the story that led to the center. It began when he set out on a backpacking trip around the world in 1973 after graduating from the University of Georgia. While bodysurfing off a beach in Rio de Janeiro, he nearly drowned when a wave slammed his body against the ocean floor. James, 22 at the time, was instantly paralyzed from the neck down.

After spending five weeks in a Brazilian hospital struggling to survive, he returned to the U.S. and with his parents and located a rehabilitation treatment facility in Colorado. After six months of intensive rehabilitation, James regained his ability to walk while using a cane and a leg brace.

After returning home to Atlanta, the Shepherd family was frustrated with the lack of rehabilitation care options in the Southeast. With his parents' enthusiastic support, James founded Shepherd Center in 1975 as a six-bed unit operating out of leased space in an Atlanta hospital.

In 1982, Shepherd Center moved to its current location on Peachtree Road in Atlanta's Buckhead neighborhood, becoming a free-standing 40-bed facility. Ten years later, the center doubled its size, and in 1995 it opened a 20-bed unit for people with acquired brain injuries and added Shepherd Pathways, a residential rehabilitation center in neighboring Decatur.

In 2007, Shepherd Center nearly doubled the size of the hospital and announced plans to build a \$16 million residential center adjacent to the hospital to provide temporary housing for families of patients.

Martin Turbidy introduced the program.
