Jerry Schueneman

Jerry, who joined our club in January, traced his life from college (DePauw University), through service in the Marine Corps, and work in the food industry and real estate until he retired here.

Jerry worked for Procter & Gamble and General Foods before opening a food brokerage and getting involved in the real estate business in Atlanta.

He said he has gone through five careers and lived in 14 cities.

Jerry, who was sponsored by John Matthews, lives with his wife Alison in Sea Palms.

Russ Marane

Russ, president of the St. Simons Land Trust, outlined his life from the University of Tennessee, where he studied urban planning, through service as an Air Force fighter pilot and work for local and federal governments before starting a land conservation program in Buford County, S.C.

Russ came to St. Simons last year after several years developing the land conservation program in the Hilton Head area.

Russ was born in Chattanooga, TN, where his father was a civil engineer for the Tennessee Valley Authority. His father's work took the family to Turkey and Brazil, among other places.

Trained by the Air Force as an F-100 pilot, Russ crosstrained in the Huey helicopter and flew missions in the early stages of the Vietnam conflict.

He lives here with his wife Daphne.
