Ed Bruce Scholarship Awards

Sonny Doehring, chairman of our club's Scholarship Fund Trustees, explained that when Ed Bruce started the fund, it provided loans to students, but later changed to a scholarship fund.

It provides \$30,000 to \$40,000 per year in scholarships, based on income from an endowment that stands at almost \$700,000. Currently, 13 students are receiving scholarships at such schools as the University of Georgia, Georgia Tech, and Coastal Georgia Community College (just to name a few).

Becky Farrow, chairman of the Scholarship Committee, introduced the winners and their families in attendance. Five students received four-year scholarships (\$2,000 per year) and two students received two-year scholarships (\$1,000 per year).
