- **Bill Marshall:** Created and designed the Rotary Scout Building; club president 1954-55.
- **Gil Tharp:** Active for more than 35 years in our club; major benefactor to Permanent Fund of Rotary International and the St. Simons Rotary Foundation. The District 6920 Scholarship is named for him.
- Lou Sobke: Longtime club member; responsible for founding Taps at Twilight.
