Sam Shaw 1924 - 2007

The club held a moment of silence in memory of club member Samuel Leslie Shaw, known to all as Sam, who died June 21 at the Brunswick hospital of the Southeast Georgia Health System.

Born in Newark, NJ, he lived most of his adult life in Mount Vernon, III, where he was a successful insurance representative for New York Life. He was a graduate of the University of Illinois.

As a long-time Rotary member, he was well known as a storyteller, always ready with a joke to enliven a meeting.

He was a member of St. Simons Presbyterian Church. His wife, Patricia, and three children survive him.

A service to celebrate his life was held July 5 at St. Simons Presbyterian Church. A graveside service was to be held later in Mount Vernon.

June 26, 2007 President's Final Report

Pat Storino said his year as president of the St. Simons Island Rotary Club was one of "challenges and opportunities."

He noted the club trip to the Jacksonville Suns baseball game and our First Tuesday at the Pub gatherings as being very successful in developing fellowship.

The club's biggest and most important club event was the annual Taps at Twilight Memorial Day program, he said, noting that it was attended by 2100 persons. He also praised the Veterans Walk and Flag programs, pointing out that Cal Paynter reluctantly turned the Flag operation over to a committee after years of individual service.

Pat said the main challenges before the club are increases in club membership and in knowledge and support of the Rotary Foundation. He said the membership committee did an outstanding job in recruiting high caliber new members, but those efforts were undermined by an abnormally high attrition rate. The club gained 11 new members, but lost 20, he said, and we also have 10 members on leaves of absences.

He challenged each club member to make a "serious commitment" to actively search out dedicated individuals and invite them to become Rotarians.
