Classification Talk Paul Sanders

In what he described as a “semi-classification” talk, the veteran real estate appraiser recounted the years he spent as a consultant for several real estate projects in Chile.

He talked about the political upheaval in the South American country following the presidential election in 1970 of avowed Marxist Dr. Salvador Allende. This was followed by the overthrow of Allende and the political ascension of Augusto Pinochet, who was head of the Chile Army.

Paul said Pinochet brought stability to the country, as well as an economic recovery based on free trade and a market-based economy.

Paul was in Chile in the early 1980s, when Pinochet won election to the presidency with 69% of the vote.

“Chile prospered under Pinochet and the economic recovery amazed the economists of the world,” Paul said. “Pinochet methods are now taught at the leading universities of the world. He was truly the savior of Chile.”

Later, Paul said, Pinochet led a return to democracy in Chile with an election, which he lost. Pinochet stepped down, but remained head of the Army until he retired at 80. Pinochet died several months ago at 92.

“He is much maligned as a brutal dictator, but the truth is that he saved Chile from the ravages of Communism and brilliantly turned the economy from a severe depression to a booming economy,” Paul said.
