John Oxendine Georgia State Insurance Commissioner

The insurance commissioner made it clear in his speech that he works for the people of Georgia.

"You're my boss," he told St. Simons Island Rotarians.

To illustrate that point, he listed a number of changes he made to his office after beginning his first term in 1995. (He was re-elected to his fourth four-year term in 2006.)

Among those changes was extending office hours to 7 p.m. to accommodate working Georgians.

He said Georgia has the cheapest homeowners insurance in the Southeast, and even its coastal areas have lower costs for this type of insurance than other coastal areas in the Southeast. He added that although some insurance companies would like to insure homes only in the non-coastal areas, his office requires them to cover the entire state – including the coast – to be allowed to sell insurance here.

He urged Georgians to change smoke detector batteries twice a year and to do a home fire drill.

Commissioner Oxendine grew up in Dekalb County and received his bachelor and law degrees from Mercer University in Macon.

In addition to being the state's insurance commissioner, Oxendine also is the Safety Fire Commissioner, Industrial Loan Commissioner and Comptroller General. His duties include regulating 1600 insurance companies, licensing 105,000 insurance agents, and regulating more than 1000 industrial loan offices (companies that make loans of \$3,000 or less).

Each year, the safety fire division of Oxendine's office is responsible for investigating approximately 700 fires, inspecting 85,000 manufactured homes, and inspecting 12,000 public buildings for state fire code compliance.

Prior to taking office as commissioner, he was with the law firm of Oxendine & Associates.

He resides in Gwinnett County with his wife Ivy and their three children.
