District Governor Dick Hyer

Governor Hyer, speaking to our club and helping present Paul Harris Fellow designations to 14 members, called the Rotary Foundation the “heartbeat of Rotary International.”

He noted that foundation funds (totaling \$120 million) have helped eradicate polio from 95% of the world (only four countries still have instances of the dreaded disease). He encouraged Rotarians to become at least sustaining members of the foundation.

The Rotary Foundation and membership recruiting are the two top goals of Rotary International President Wilfred J. Wilkinson, Governor Hyer said, with battling world hunger as another important mission.

Governor Hyer said he has visited 42 clubs in District 6920. He said it was “exhausting, but very rewarding, because Rotarians “represent everything that is good about the world.”

Our club, he said, is one of the “most outstanding clubs in the district...perhaps in all of Rotary.” That comment drew a round of applause from members.

The district governor is a native of Jacksonville, FL, with undergraduate and graduate degrees from Mercer University. He received a master of arts degree from Western Michigan University and a doctorate in education from the University of Georgia.

He is a member of the Macon Rotary Club, where he has served as president, club administrator and on the board of directors. He was assistant governor for Middle Georgia in 2002-2003. A Rotarian since 1976, he is a multiple Paul Harris Fellow and Will Watt Fellow.

During his professional career, he taught in the Mercer University Department of Education, and served as superintendent for the Georgia Academy for the Blind for 26 years.

He is married to Marsha Liles Hyer, who is a member of the Macon Rotary Club. They have three children.

Governor Hyer was introduced by Assistant Governor Pat Storino.
