Wesley Cox **General Manager of WCGA Talk Radio**

The general manager of news/talk radio 1100 WCGA, told SSI Rotarians that radio is both his business and his passion.

He has owned the 10,000-watt station – the most powerful AM station in Coastal Georgia – since 1988. Its signal can be picked up from Savannah, GA, to St. Augustine, FL.

The station carries such talk show hosts as Glenn Beck, Dave Ramsey, Dr. Laura and Michael Reagan.

He said the qualities of radio – being ubiquitous and free – make it an essential part of our lives.

He was not as enthusiastic about another broadcast medium – television – saying his family put the TV set “in the shed” in 1986 and has been “TV-free” since that time.

He was born and raised in Georgia (achieving Eagle Scout status) and is a graduate of Valdosta State, where he majored in English and edited The Spectator.

He is married for 30 years to the former De Russell of Incachee Plantation, Waverly, in Camden County, and they have four children.

The station owner summed up his life this way: “My wife still loves me and my dog Sparky comes when I call him.

Proposed Change in Bylaws

The board of directors recommended a change to club bylaws that would exempt the secretary and treasurer from paying regular dues and fees, because of the work involved in performing those duties.

The change also would give the secretary and treasurer the option to share the exemption with the assistant secretary and assistant treasurer “as they believe appropriate.”
