Guerry Hersey

Former U.S. Treasury Special Agent

A former Treasury Special Agent, Guerry Hersey has been a consultant, primarily in Indonesia, for the past several years.

He gave a talk on Indonesia, which he said is at the center of the war on terror. The diverse nation is composed of 17,520 islands, with 300 different ethnic groups, he said.

Hersey is a Certified Fraud Examiner and an expert in anti-money laundering and financial/tax crimes. For 27 years he was a special agent with the Criminal Investigation Division of the IRS, where he was case agent in the successful prosecution of organized crime figures, state-elected politicians and international narcotic traffickers.

For nine years he was a member of the undercover cadre, infiltrating domestic terrorist groups and international money laundering operations.

Hersey was case agent/consultant on an international money laundering case which resulted in more than \$52,000,000 in assets repatriated and forfeited to US government, conviction of two attorneys, and temporary incarceration and disbarment of F. Lee Bailey.

He has held positions as Special Agent and Resident Lead Instructor at the National Criminal Investigator Academy for the Internal Revenue Service, Department of Treasury; Senior Instructor for the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center Department of Homeland Security; and Anti-Money Laundering, Anti-Corruption and Terrorism Financing Expert for the United Nations Office of Drug Control, USAID and the Department of Justice.

For the last four years he has worked exclusively in Indonesia, developing that country's capacity to combat the financing of terrorism. He designed, developed and delivered training in Indonesia to legislators, judges, prosecutors, investigators, auditors and regulators, which led to his being awarded in 2005 the Anti-Money Laundering Professional of the Year by the Association of Certified Anti-Money Laundering Specialists.

Hersey's wife, Maureen, is librarian for the St. Simons Island Library.
