Amy joined the Marine Corps after high school “because it was the toughest.” She became a C-130 mechanic and met Jack, who became her husband. In the next phase of her life, she became an interior designer, a mother and moved from California to Georgia. She worked as an interior designer for H&H Lifestyles, and then decided to change careers, becoming a real estate appraiser. Her fast-moving life continued to evolve when she ran successfully for the Glynn County Commission (she will take office in January 2009).

Mike Flores

Mike was born in Miami, FL, and was graduated from the University of Notre Dame, after which he began a long career in banking. He worked at C&S (now Bank of America) before becoming a consultant in the banking industry. He noted the tumult in the financial markets, despite the fact 92% of loans are “still performing.” The real problem, he said, is in credit default swaps, a complicated procedure for “insuring” credit investments. “Why wasn’t it regulated?” he asked. “It is frightening,” Mike said, but “we’ll get through it.”

Cathey Petkash

Born in Missouri, Cathey moved to North Carolina in 1983, where she “fell in love” with that state’s beaches, promising herself that “someday I am going to live on an island.” She worked for Hewlett-Packard for 18 years, traveling the world. She moved to Atlanta in 2000, becoming involved in volunteer work for My House, a nonprofit organization that provides a home-like environment for babies who are ready to leave the hospital but have nowhere to go. Cathey is the owner-manager of a florist shop, Edward on St. Simons.
