Juvenile Court Judge George M. Rountree

Juvenile Court Judge George Rountree said his and other juvenile courts are on the "front line" of societal challenges that he finds "disturbing."

He said it is unusual for a juvenile to come before him who has two parents in the home. Substance abuse and mental health issues are common, he added. And more recently, he said, his court sees evidence of gang activities.

Born in Brunswick, Judge Rountree is a native of this area and a long-time resident of St. Simons Island. He and his wife, Donna, have seven children and nine grandchildren.

A graduate of Glynn Academy, he holds degrees from Florida State University, where he was on a baseball scholarship (playing first base), and the University of Georgia School of Law. Since January 2004, he has been Juvenile Court Judge for the Brunswick Judicial Circuit, with primary responsibility for Glynn County. He had a general law practice in Brunswick from 1975 to 2003. **(Gary Schwartz introduced the speaker.)**
