Glynn County Commissioner-Elect

The commissioner-elect said expansion of the county jail at its current site is not the "highest and best use" of downtown property.

Even if the downtown jail site is expanded, the county eventually will end up building in the county anyway because of future expansion needs, he said.

He noted, however, that four of the returning commissioners favor the downtown expansion, giving them a majority on the seven-member commission.

Sublett was born and grew up mainly in Virginia, although he did live in Florida for a couple of years during childhood.

He has three college degrees, all from Virginia schools, including a bachelor's degree from Virginia Tech.

He worked for Fortune 100 corporations, including McCormick & Company and Sara Lee Corporation, prior to becoming senior vice president for King & Prince Seafood here for eight years.

After 25 years in industry, he semi-retired after the sale of King & Prince Seafood and now sells real estate part-time for Parker-Kaufman Realtors. He is involved in many local community organizations, including being past chairman of the Chamber of Commerce, member of the Rotary Club of Brunswick, former Chairman and current board member of Coastal Georgia United Way, board member of the Communities of Coastal Georgia Foundation, a Live Oak Society member of the Land Trust, and Junior Warden of St. Mark's Episcopal Church in Brunswick.

He has been visiting the Golden Isles area since the 1970s and has worked and lived here since 1999. He will begin his four-year Glynn County Commission term in January, replacing Uli Keller.

He and his wife, Carol, have two daughters and two sons. They live in Hamilton Landing on St. Simons.
