

Georgia Trend Magazine

Publisher Neely Young, whose magazine publishes an annual economic report on the state, said the Atlanta area and parts of northwest Georgia are having problems, but the rest of Georgia is doing better.

He said two million people are expected to move to Georgia in the next 10 years.

Born in Cedartown, GA, Young attended school there and was graduated from the University of Georgia in 1965. He worked at newspapers in Valdosta, Marietta, Canton, Dalton and Clayton County before becoming CEO of Morris Newspaper Corporation, owner of 40 newspapers in six states.

In 1989 he formed Southern Publishing Company with Tom Cousins and for nine years built a chain of 13 Georgia newspapers. Southern Publishing was sold in 1999 and Young purchased Georgia Trend, a 50,000-circulation business and political magazine published in all 159 Georgia counties.

He has served as president of the Georgia Press Association and on the board of the University of Georgia Henry W. Grady School of Journalism.

He has been president of the Clayton County Rotary Club and chaired the Clayton County Chamber of Commerce. He serves on several boards, including the Georgia Chamber of Commerce and the Metro Atlanta Chamber of Commerce.

He and his wife, Kathy, live in Marietta. They have two sons and one grandson.
