Page Faulk

Page talked about his life in medicine. A graduate of The University of the South and Tulane University School of Medicine, the well-traveled physician worked for the World Health Organization in Geneva, Switzerland. Later, he was Professor and Vice Chairman of the Department of Immunology at the Medical University of South Carolina in Charleston. In 1986 he was invited to build a Center for Reproduction and Transplantation Immunology at the University of Indiana Medical School's Methodist Hospital in Indianapolis. Page and his wife, who also is a doctor, started a pharmaceutical company in 2002 for the development of new approaches to chemotherapy.

Brian Peebles

Brian, a banker, said he honed his sales skills early in life, selling "smooth rocks" to his classmates in grade school. After graduation from Georgia College and State University in Milledgeville, GA, he managed restaurants in Vail, CO, before going to Atlanta to join the J.C. Penney Company. He later moved to Brunswick to work for Alltel, then moved into banking, first at SunTrust Bank and then at his current employer, BB&T.

Gus Hernandez

A native of Colombia, South America, Gus attended medical school in Bogota and the University of Tennessee. He trained as a radiologist, spent a year in Vietnam and was on the University of Kentucky medical faculty. He opened a private practice in Kingspoint, TN. After retiring, Gus and his wife, Barbara, moved to St. Simons Island. They have two children and two grandchildren.
