Feb. 24, 2009 Ben Slade

Brunswick, Glynn County Development

Ben Slade gave club members a lesson on the "fabulous history" of Brunswick and the surrounding area.

Brunswick, he said, has had many ups and downs in terms of development and population.

Our speaker was chairman of Blueprint Brunswick from 2003 to 2005, at which time the organization disbanded and its functions were absorbed by the City of Brunswick. Blueprint Brunswick, Slade said, was an effort to reverse the decline of the city and recapture its sense of history.

Blueprint Brunswick was a non-profit corporation charged with implementation of a comprehensive revitalization plan for the historic peninsula of Brunswick.

Born in Savannah, Slade attended high schools in Brunswick and Atlanta before graduating from Vanderbilt University. Following a tour as a Navy officer, he returned with his family to Brunswick in 1961 and began a 36-year career with First Federal Savings Bank of Brunswick.

At retirement, Slade was chairman and chief executive officer of First Federal. He is currently managing partner of Slade Investments.

He is past chairman of the Brunswick-Glynn County Economic Development Authority. He was founding president of Habitat for Humanity of Glynn and founding chairman of the St. Simons Land Trust.

He is a member and former senior warden of Christ Church Frederica. He and his wife Sylvia live on St. Simons Island. They have three sons and a daughter, and eight granddaughters and three grandsons.
