# Bert Brown Habitat for Humanity

Gary Schwartz introduced Bert Brown. Brown is a 26-year resident of Glynn County, moving to the area in 1983 with the Burroughs Corporation.

He has been the executive director of Habitat for Humanity of Glynn County for the last seven months, where he has brought business disciplines to the position, including strategic and project planning.

Bert has been married to Ann for 25 years and they have one son, Seaton. Seaton is a senior at the College of Charleston, scheduled to graduate in May with a double major in Business and Hospitality and Tourism Management. Seaton is also the President of the Student Body. The Browns attend St. Simons United Methodist Church.

Bert explained all the basics of Habitat, including:

- Exactly what is Habitat?
- · History including the founding by Millard Fuller in 1976;
- Standards for the homes;
- Eligibility and mortgages for the homes;
- Process and functions of volunteers;
- Donations of money & materials;
- Handling of funding;
- Specifically how donations are processed and used.

Brown's interesting presentation was accompanied by appropriate and interesting slides.

A 15-minute question-and-answer session followed his talk.
