Honoring Tom Swan

A moment of silence was held at the May 5 meeting in honor of Tom Swan, who died May 1. Tom had a long career with General Electric Co. Among the survivors is his wife of 58 years, Dawn Reed Swan. A memorial mass was held at 10 a.m. on Saturday, May 9, at St. Williams Catholic Church.

May 5, 2009 John Turbidy Restoration of Lady Liberty

Club member John Turbidy, former board chairman of the Statue of Liberty-Ellis Island Foundation, outlined the successful efforts that restored two great American monuments.

John was one of the original directors of the foundation that raised more than \$500 million for the restorations. He served as a director for 25 years, chairman of the investment committee for 10 years, and board chairman for four years prior to his retirement in 2008.

John told club members that "not a cent of government money" was used in the two restorations.

John grew up in Rome, Georgia, and was graduated from Duke University. He started his career with Lockheed shortly after the Marietta, Georgia, plant opened. He served in the U.S. Navy during the Korean War.

In 1956, he joined McKinsey & Co., a prominent management consulting firm in New York. Later, he moved to London as one of the firm's first international consultants.

John spent the 1960s in Europe, living in London, Brussels, Rome and Sicily. He served as a corporate officer of three multinational companies: ITT, Celanese and IU International.

After leaving the industrial world, John spent 10 years in investment banking and investment management. In 1990, he organized a small consulting firm to assist companies facing financial crisis, occasionally serving as chief executive in extreme cases.

After his first wife passed away, John met and married his wife Jackie, a Virginian transplanted to the New York area. It was then he decided he had spent enough 60-hour weeks, and he retired.

In 2003, Jackie and John moved to St. Simons and have never regretted that decision for a moment.

(John was introduced by his brother, Martin.)
