Rana Smith

Executive Director Safe Harbor Children's Shelter

Rana M. Smith, executive director of Safe Harbor Children's Shelter, gave club members an overview of the organization's program to provide a safe and secure emergency shelter for children and youth who are abused, neglected, runaway or homeless.

Originally from Belleville, Michigan (near Ann Arbor), Ms. Smith has been in Brunswick for almost two years. She has an extensive background in social services, and has nearly 20 years' experience in executive management.

Ms. Smith has been with Safe Harbor since June of 2008. Currently, she travels between Georgia and Michigan to raise her 14- year- old daughter (Gabrielle).

She has brought significant changes and new initiatives to Safe Harbor, such as moving the boys to a new facility, getting more men involved, and shifting Safe Harbor's status from a mostly temporary facility to a mostly permanent one.

Ms. Smith said she has a "passion to work with children. She leads a staff of 27 and 30 volunteers. There are separate facilities for 12 girls and 8 boys.

Safe Harbor opened in June 1991 on Gloucester Street in Brunswick. It is a member of the National Safe Place organization, which supports many agencies around the country. It provides services to school-age children up to 18 years old.

CART Fund

Club member and District Governor-Elect Clyde Taylor gave a report on CART (Coins for Alzheimer's Research Trust), a joint project of District 6920 and 10 other clubs in Georgia and the Carolinas.

Clyde said our club has contributed the second most of any club in the district.

He noted that CART research has resulted in "major breakthroughs" in fighting the disease.
